

## TRANSLATION WITHOUT LEGAL VALUE

### Art. 7 CODE ON THE MATTER OF PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

(Law No. 196/2003)

#### Right to access to personal data and other rights

1. Parties concerned have the right to know whether or not there are personal data about them, even if they have not been registered yet, and the right to be informed about them in an intelligible way.
2. Parties concerned have the right to obtain the information about:
  - a) the source of their personal data;
  - b) purposes and procedures connected with data processing;
  - c) the logical principle that rules the data processing by automatic tools;
  - d) the essential data of the owner of the processing rights, the persons in charge and the designated representative in accordance with art. 5, paragraph 2;
  - e) the subjects or the categories of subjects who can be informed about personal data or who can become acquainted with them as designated representatives of the State on the spot or persons in charge.
3. Parties concerned have the right to:
  - a) obtain the updating, the correction or the integration of their data when they need;
  - b) have their data cancelled, turned into anonymous or inaccessible if processed in violation of Law, included those that are unnecessary to be filed according to the purposes which they were collected or processed for;
  - c) obtain the documentary evidence that those to whom their data were communicated or divulged have been informed about the operations described in items a) and b), and about their contents, except in case this is impossible or should means definitely out of proportion to the protected right be employed.
4. Parties concerned have the right to totally or partly oppose:
  - a) for legitimate reasons, the processing of their personal data even if they are relevant to the purposes of the process;
  - b) the processing of their personal data with the object of sending advertising materials or direct selling or marketing research or commercial communications .
